In early 2007, the Exposition Construction Authority, in cooperation with the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority, began a study to extend Phase 1 of the Expo Line from the current planned terminus at Washington/National in Culver City to a station near 5th Street/Colorado in Santa Monica.

Last spring, we held a series of scoping meetings to obtain community input regarding the project. The various alternatives that were originally considered and those that emerged through the scoping process have undergone initial screening.
